DECISION

Table and Vine, Inc. dba Town and Country Liquors, Inc.

Table and Vine, Inc. dba Town and Country Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 9, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Paul Capurso's Compliance Check Field Report.

FACTS


1. On, May 4, 2011 at approximately 6:07 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Table and Vine, Inc. dba Town and Country Liquors.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a can of Bud Light for two dollars and fifty-two cents (\$2.52). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. Administrative review of the licensee's files indicates this was the first violation by the licensee in any of their three (3) locations since first being licensed in 1962.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
