


RELEASE

In consideration of the payment of \$142,000, and contingent upon receipt of full payment, the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority ("MBTA"), a body politic and corporate established by M.G.L. c. 161A, §2, for itself, its successors, officers, employees, representatives and assigns, hereby releases Bechtel Infrastructure Corp. ("Bechtel"), a Nevada corporation with a principal place of business in Frederick, Maryland, PB Americas Inc. ("PB") f/k/a Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas, Inc., a New York corporation with a principal place of business in New York, New York and Bechtel Parsons Brinckerhoff ("B/PB"), a joint venture of Bechtel and PB, with its principal place of business in Boston, Massachusetts, their respective corporate heirs, successors, assigns, and affiliates, and parent corporations, including all employees, officers, directors, servants, attorneys, and agents thereof, from all causes of action, claims and damages relating to or arising out of the July 10, 2006 incident in which concrete ceiling panels and associated components over the eastbound travel lanes on the I-90 Connector tunnel fell onto the roadway and crushed a traveling vehicle, resulting in the death of the passenger and injury to the driver.
