**RE: September 2, 2015 - Listening Session**

Dear Chairman Miller:

I am writing to you as the Executive Director of the Massachusetts Chapters of the American Institute of Architects (AIA MA) regarding the public outreach meeting on September 2, 2015 to solicit ideas and suggestions for potential revisions to 231 CMR 2.00-4.00, the regulations governing architects.

Established in 1963, AIA MA represents over 5,000 architects, design professionals and allied members statewide. We are the state chapter of our national organization, the AIA, which consists of over 85,000 members representing more than 200,000 U.S. jobs.

AIA MA fully supports the Board in moving the entirety of the November 2014 draft regulations proposals, which also includes the May 2015 update to CMR Section 4.04 (1) (a) 2 a and b, into the Administrations EO 562 review process. We hope this review process will move quickly and that clearance will be given. We offer our assistance in whatever way the Board deems appropriate in helping to clear the EO 562 process. We understand the EO 562 process to be first step toward an eventual Secretary of States Chapter 30A public hearing, and it is after that hearing in which the Board can finally vote final promulgation.

As we have been working with this Board for over two years on the draft 231 CMR, the time has come to move toward final promulgation.
