

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT AS LAND COURT TITLE EXAMINER

- You must be a member of The Massachusetts Bar for a period of not less than three years and have some background experience in the conveyancing area.
- The following information must be submitted with your request for appointment:
 - A brief resume including your educational background, year of admission to the bar and experience in the field.
 - Two letters of recommendation from members of The Massachusetts Bar familiar with your work.
 - An abstract of title you have completed
- All of the foregoing should be submitted as a single package. Once all of these items have been received, and reviewed, the Court will contact you.
- If you are appointed as a Land Court Title Examiner, you will need to fill out and return the following form.
