**DELINQUENCY NOTICE**  
**(Pursuant to Mass. Gen. L. ch. 234A, sec. 43)**

**FAILURE to APPEAR for JUROR SERVICE**

Our records indicate that on [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] COURTHOUSE you failed to appear for juror service as scheduled. **Therefore, you have been placed in delinquency status and have thirty (30) days from the date of this notice to remove yourself from delinquency. Failure to do so will result in criminal prosecution because failing to respond to a juror summons is a criminal offense.**

*Also, **please note that** Mass. Gen. L. ch. 90, sec. 22 requires the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to suspend the license of any person for whom there is an outstanding default or arrest warrant.*

**PROCEDURE FOR REMOVAL FROM DELINQUENCY STATUS:**

Please refer to the back of this notice for instructions on removing yourself from delinquency status. **If you remain delinquent at the end of this thirty (30) day period, this office will file an application for criminal complaint against you. If a complaint issues and you are convicted, you may be fined up to two thousand dollars (\$2,000) or be required to perform community service.**

If you believe that you do not qualify for jury duty or that you have been improperly placed in delinquency status, then you must contact the Office of Jury Commissioner at:

## HOW TO RESOLVE YOUR DELINQUENCY STATUS

### **██████████ Courthouse**

In order to resolve your delinquency, you must EITHER:

- Perform jury duty by appearing at your assigned courthouse within thirty days of the date that appears on this notice, OR
- Provide the Office of Jury Commissioner with proof of a legitimate disqualification.

### TO PERFORM JURY DUTY:

1. CALL THE OFFICE OF JURY COMMISSIONER AT ONE OF THE TELEPHONE NUMBERS LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS PAGE TO RESCHEDULE THE DATE OF YOUR JURY DUTY.
2. THE DAY BEFORE THE DATE YOU HAVE BEEN RESCHEDULED FOR JURY DUTY, CALL THE COURT'S RECORDED JUROR LINE ██████████ **AFTER 3:30 P.M.** TO LEARN IF THE COURT IS REQUIRING JURORS TO REPORT FOR JURY DUTY THE FOLLOWING DAY.
3. YOU SHOULD REPORT TO THE COURTHOUSE **AT 8:00 AM** TO PERFORM JURY DUTY, UNLESS ALL JUROR GROUPS ARE CANCELLED. **PLEASE BRING THIS DELINQUENCY NOTICE WITH YOU FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES ONLY.**
4. IF ALL JUROR GROUPS ARE CANCELLED, THEN **DO NOT REPORT** BUT CONTINUE TO REPEAT STEPS 1, 2, AND 3 ABOVE UNTIL JUROR GROUPS ARE REQUIRED TO APPEAR.
5. IF YOU HAVE ACCESS TO THE INTERNET, VISIT OUR WEBSITE AT [www.MAjury.gov](http://www.MAjury.gov) AND CLICK ON THE "CONFIDENTIAL JUROR QUESTIONNAIRE" LINK AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE. COMPLETE AND PRINT THE CONFIDENTIAL JUROR QUESTIONNAIRE AND BRING THE COMPLETED QUESTIONNAIRE WITH YOU TO THE COURTHOUSE ON YOUR SERVICE DATE.

*Remember: In order to be removed from delinquency status, you must physically appear at the courthouse and serve on a day when jurors are required to report. If jurors are cancelled for the date you have been rescheduled, you must call the Office of Jury Commissioner to be rescheduled again because juror cancellation does not resolve your delinquency status.*

### DISQUALIFICATION OR QUESTIONS:

If you believe that you do not qualify for jury duty, or that you have been improperly placed in delinquency status, or if you are unsure about what to do to remove yourself from delinquency status,
