**STATE POLICE REQUEST THE PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING
WOMAN FOUND BOUND AND BURNED IN BRIDGEWATER**

BROCKTON – State Police assigned to the Plymouth County District Attorney's Office, Bridgewater Police and MBTA Police are investigating the discovery of a burned body found late Tuesday night in Bridgewater.

Bridgewater Police received a 911 call at approximately 11:40 pm Tuesday night for a report of suspicious activity in the area of the railroad tracks at Oak and Crapo Streets in Bridgewater. Upon arrival, Bridgewater Police discovered a fire burning on the west side of the tracks and determined that it was a human body burning. Bridgewater Fire responded, extinguished the fire and determined the victim, believed to be a female, deceased.

State Police Detectives assigned to the Plymouth County District Attorney's Office, State Police Crime Lab Services, State Police Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Section, the State Fire Marshal, and MBTA Police were all contacted and an investigation into the suspicious death was initiated.

The body is believed to be that of a woman and was found with the hands tied behind the victim and the feet tied together. The body was transported to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner where the manner and cause of death will be determined.
