TOPIC: ADDITIONAL LANDLINE TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH DATA
FISCAL YEAR 2010 – FCC CATEGORIES

On May 15, 2009 the Commissioner of Revenue posted the certified full and fair cash valuation of taxable telephone and telegraph machinery, poles, wires and underground conduits, wires and pipes of the [centrally valued landline telephone and telegraph companies](#), as of January 1, 2009 for FY2010.

At that time a memorandum said that we would post additional data to the Internet for these centrally valued landline companies by June 15, 2009. We are releasing that information today.

Companies are required to report their personal property to the Department of Revenue using Federal Communications Commission (FCC) categories. We have aggregated the companies' valuation data by FCC category for each company and relevant community. In some instances you will notice a slight difference from the totals initially reported, these are rounding differences only. The certified values issued on May 15, 2009 should be used for tax rate setting purposes and for issuing tax bills to companies.

The additional data by FCC Code is on the website previously referenced in a pivot table that operates in the same way as the FY2010 Centrally Valued Landline Telephone and Telegraph Values pivot table.
