SUBJECT: "What's New In Municipal Law" Seminar

The Division of Local Services' Legal Staff will offer the seminar "What's New in Municipal Law" Friday, September 26, 2008, at The Log Cabin Banquet & Meeting House in Holyoke and Friday, October 3, 2008, at Lantana in Randolph. Presentations will include new legislation and recent court decisions pertaining to local government. This Bulletin contains a program description (page 2) and a registration form (page 3).

The general session in the morning will be conducted by attorneys Kathleen Colleary, Chief of the Bureau of Municipal Finance Law, Gary Blau, James Crowley, Christopher Hinchey, Mary Mitchell and Daniel Murphy. The afternoon session will consist of three simultaneous workshops from 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. These workshops will be small group meetings, led by the Bureau of Municipal Finance Law attorneys.

The attorneys of the Bureau of Municipal Finance Law are specialists in municipal law, particularly in property taxation and finance. The legal staff interprets new laws and responds to the legal concerns of local officials.
