Here are some tips on how to prepare for your advising appointment and what to expect. This worksheet is designed to help you think about the role you have in the advising process and your academic success. Before your appointment with your academic advisor you should think about your goals and expectations from school and from yourself for the upcoming semester. You should also prepare yourself for making decisions about your upcoming course schedule.

Getting ready for your advising appointment

- (1) Schedule an appointment date/time with your advisor. Sign-up early to get the courses and times you want.
- (2) Review the campus course catalog.
- (3) Gather the following information for your appointment:
 - Use a schedule planner to organize your classes, transportation, homework and free time.
 - Create a wish list of classes. ICE students are eligible to take a maximum of 6 credits per semester.
 - Review your schedule planner and wish list with your family, ed coach and high school liaison.
- (4) We will review your transcript, mid-term grades, and student-ed coach agreement during your advising appointment.
