

# Results of Online Feedback Survey – November 3, 2016 Spring Title I & Title IIA Statewide Conference

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The Department would like to thank all respondents for taking the time to complete the online evaluation of the November 3, 2016 Title I & Title IIA Statewide Conference. Your feedback is greatly appreciated as we seek to improve the delivery of Title I technical assistance.

## Participant Information

We received 92 responses to the survey. The majority of respondents (81%) are from districts with one to five Title I schools. About half of districts (52%) have an FY17 Title I grant of \$300,000 or more. About 36% of attendees have been responsible for the district’s Title I program for two years or less; the rest (64%) have been in the role for three or more years. More than half of respondents (58%) hold the position of Title I Director, but many hold other roles as well, including Title IIA Director (32%), Director of Curriculum and Instruction (19%), Grant Manager (14%), Assistant Superintendent (6%), Title I teacher (6%), and Principal (4%).
