**PUBLIC NOTICE OF APPROVAL
OF PROPOSED CHANGE TO THE
MASSACHUSETTS COASTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

The Massachusetts Office of Coastal Zone Management (CZM) within the Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs serves as the lead agency for implementing the state's Coastal Management Program.

As published in the Massachusetts Register on August 24, 2011 and the Environmental Monitor on August 19, 2011, CZM submitted proposed changes to the Massachusetts Coastal Management Program to the Office of the Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (OCRM) of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). Massachusetts considered these program changes to be routine and requested OCRM's concurrence in this determination.

By letter dated September 23, 2011, OCRM approved the proposed changes to Massachusetts's Coastal Management Program. Pursuant to C.F.R. §923.84(b)(4), the approved changes to enforceable policies are effective as of the publication date of this Public Notice.
