At the public meeting, DCR will review the project's final design and provide information on the construction plan and plans to mitigate construction impacts.

The bridge was constructed circa 1887 and converted in 1993 for recreational use as part of the Norwottuck Rail Trail, a 10.6 mile greenway that extends from Northampton to Belchertown. The estimated cost for the project, including engineering, design, and construction, is \$415,000. The funding for the project is being provided by the Patrick-Murray Administration's Accelerated Bridge Program.
