At this meeting, DCR will present an update on Segment 1 of the project, addressing construction plans and traffic impacts for the 3.5-mile greenway from St. Paul Street to Route 146A, including the Main Street Bridge, Church Street Tunnel, and Triad Bridge in Blackstone. Information on a feasibility study for Segment 2 construction of three miles of greenway in Uxbridge will also be presented. The meeting will include opportunities for question-and-answer and for public input.
