Proposal for Riverfront Park Restoration along Greenough Boulevard in Cambridge and Watertown

At this meeting, DCR and The Solomon Foundation will further discuss a proposal to reconfigure Greenough Boulevard and restore riverfront property between the Eliot Bridge in Cambridge and the Arsenal Street Bridge in Watertown, to include a new, mile-long, multi-use path along the Charles River.

This represents a follow up to a previous public meeting held on the subject in early March. The meeting will include a discussion of the impacts of reconfiguring the roadway, a response to comments received, and suggested refinements to the park design.
