DCR and Historic Boston, Inc. have partnered on a feasibility study for future reuse options for the Charles River Speedway Building, including an updated conditions assessment, marketing analysis, preparation of cost estimates, and conceptual renderings for redevelopment options. The Feasibility Report will guide DCR's future decision-making regarding the reuse and preservation of the building, one of the agency's most historically significant structures. The Boston Preservation Alliance facilitated preliminary discussion of the reuse options in the spring of 2011 by hosting a public design charrette.

At the public meeting, DCR and Historic Boston, Inc. will present, and obtain public input on, a draft Feasibility Report. The final Feasibility Report is expected to be completed in March 2012.
