

Massachusetts Rape Crisis Centers offer **free**, confidential services for adolescent and adult survivors - and for people who care about survivors of all ages. Trained rape crisis counselors at local rape crisis programs:

- Provide 24/7 hotline counseling, information and referrals.
- Will meet a sexual assault survivor 24/7 at a hospital or a police station.
- Will go with a sexual assault survivor to court.
- Provide individual counseling - and some also provide support group counseling.
- Provide prevention education, professional training, and outreach.
