Injury-related Hospital Discharges MA Youth & Young Adults, Ages 15-24 Years

There were **4,843** injury-related hospital discharges among Massachusetts youth ages 15-24 in FY2007, a rate of 534.5 per 100,000 youth. Poisonings and motor vehicle traffic-related injuries were the leading causes of injury-related hospitalization for this age group.
