## Definition of the Report Population


The population covered in this report, termed 'release to the street population', includes any criminally sentenced inmate released to the street from a Massachusetts Department of Correction facility as well as DOC inmates released from other correctional facilities (jurisdiction). Under this definition, DOC inmates released from Massachusetts' Houses of Correction, other states' correctional facilities and the Federal Bureau of Prisons during 2009 are also included in the population. The population described in this report includes the following:

- ✦ Criminally sentenced inmates released via parole or expiration of sentence to the street.

## Introduction

Inmates under the jurisdiction of the Massachusetts Department of Correction are released to many different communities throughout the state and in some cases outside of Massachusetts. This report is a statistical look at the communities criminally sentenced inmates releasing to the street via parole or expiration of sentence intend to reside after their release<sup>1</sup>. For the purposes of this report communities may refer to counties, cities or towns, and locations outside of Massachusetts.

In calendar year 2009 there were 2,772 inmates released to the street, an increase of 53 (2%) from 2008. This increase was driven by males with 2,019 releasing in 2009 up from 1,823 in 2008. Females decreased 143, from 896 to 753 between 2008 and 2009.


Over half (54%) of the inmates released during 2009 reported a release address in one of the top ten cities listed in Table 1. The highest number reported a community in the city of Boston (20%) as their intended release address, followed by Worcester and Springfield, both with 8%.

Looking at the concentration (the rate per 100,000 residents) of releases to the street presents a different outcome, with Springfield having the greatest concentration at 145, followed by Framingham at 141, and Worcester at 127. Boston becomes seventh on the list with 84 per 100,000 residents releasing there.

Boston was the top city reported by both male (22%) and female (14%) inmates as their release address. The second most commonly reported city for males was Springfield (11%) followed by Worcester (9%). Females varied from males with a second most commonly reported release address of Worcester (8%) followed by Brockton (5%). Female releases by community are somewhat skewed due to the fact that some counties house females and some do not.<sup>2</sup>

The majority of males (59%) reported a release address in one of the top ten cities/towns. More than half of the females (52%) reported another city/town or a location outside of Massachusetts as their release address with 48% reporting a release address in one of the top ten cities/towns.



Twenty-one percent of the total population reported a release address located in Suffolk County. The Majority of female<sup>3</sup> releases were to Middlesex (23%), Worcester (20%), and Essex (16%) counties. The majority of males were released to Suffolk County (23%), followed by Hampden (16%) and Worcester (13%) counties.

Of the 2,772 inmates released to the street, 121 reported a release address outside of Massachusetts. Sixty-two percent of the inmates reporting a release address outside of Massachusetts, reported a New England state or New York (62%), with New Hampshire having the highest number (21) of inmates intending to reside there.
