CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 52

Gentlemen:

I have been directed by the Industrial Accident Board to notify you of its vote passed on Monday, November 15, 1948 as follows:

"VOTED, that effective December 1, 1948, the per diem charges for hospital services under the Workmen's Compensation Law (General Laws, chapter 152, sections 13 and 30, as amended) shall be approved by the Department of Industrial Accidents as follows:

EACH HOSPITAL SHALL RECEIVE AS PAYMENT FOR ALL ITS CHARGES AND SERVICES THE PER DIEM, ALL-INCLUSIVE IN-PATIENT COST WHICH SAID HOSPITAL HAS CERTIFIED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND WHICH HAS BEEN APPROVED BY SAID DEPARTMENT."

The per diem all-inclusive in-patient cost certified by your hospital to the Department of Public Health of the Commonwealth and approved by said Department and which this Department also approves is \$_____.
