**ORDER APPROVING CLAIM FILING DEADLINE,
FORM OF PROOF OF CLAIM, AND PUBLICATION NOTICE**

After considering the Motion for Order Approving Claim Filing Deadline, Form of Notice, and Form of Proof of Claim filed by the Commissioner of Insurance, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of Trust Assurance Company ("Trust Assurance") and the Liquidator's Affidavit filed therewith (the "Affidavit"), the Court hereby finds and orders as follows:


1. A deadline for filing all proofs of claim against Trust Assurance, pursuant to G.L. c. 175, § 180F, is hereby established as November 14, 2013.

2. The Liquidator shall give notice of the claim filing deadline to potential claimants by publishing a notice,

substantially in the form attached to the proposed form of order submitted herewith as Exhibit A, twice (fourteen days apart) in both the Boston Globe and the Boston Herald. The Liquidator shall also give notice of the claim filing deadline to potential claimants by posting such notice on the website of the Massachusetts Division of Insurance.

3. The proof of claim form, substantially in the form attached to the proposed form of order submitted herewith as Exhibit B, is approved. The Liquidator shall mail, via first class mail, postage prepaid, a blank proof of claim form to any person who requests one.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING
THE LIQUIDATION OF
TRUST ASSURANCE COMPANY**

On February 14, 2013, the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County entered an "Order of Liquidation of Trust Assurance Company and Appointment of Permanent Receiver" placing Trust Assurance Company ("Trust Assurance") into liquidation and appointing Joseph G. Murphy, Massachusetts Commissioner of Insurance, as Liquidator.

**THE DEADLINE FOR FILING CLAIMS AGAINST
TRUST ASSURANCE IS NOVEMBER 14, 2013.**

All policyholders, third party claimants, and any other persons who believe that they may have a claim against Trust Assurance must file a Proof of Claim prior to the Claim Filing Deadline of **November 14, 2013** in order to preserve their rights. Proof of Claim forms may be requested:

NOTICE AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF PROOF OF CLAIM FORM

Dear Potential Trust Assurance Company Creditor:

Effective February 14, 2013, by Order of the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County, Massachusetts Commissioner of Insurance Joseph G. Murphy was appointed Liquidator of Trust Assurance Company ("Trust Assurance"). The Court also ordered that Trust Assurance be liquidated.

IF YOU BELIEVE THAT YOU ARE OWED MONIES BY TRUST ASSURANCE, OR MAY BE OWED MONIES AT ANY TIME IN THE FUTURE, YOU MUST FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 14, 2013 OR YOUR CLAIM AGAINST THE ESTATE OF TRUST ASSURANCE WILL BE BARRED.

- You may file a Proof of Claim form (*please see reverse side*) if you believe that you have a claim, or will have a claim, against Trust Assurance for any reason.
- You must submit supporting documentation (such as itemized unpaid invoices) if your claim is for services provided to Trust Assurance.
- If your claim arises out of a loss or accident covered by an insurance policy issued by Trust Assurance, please complete the information in the upper right corner of the Proof of Claim form and answer Question #1.
- If your claim arises out of a premium refund to which you believe you are entitled, please include your insurance policy number in the upper right corner and answer Question #2.
- If your claim does **not** arise out of an insurance policy issued by Trust Assurance, please answer Question #2.

You must also sign and date each Proof of Claim form which you submit.
