

Reciprocal license application instructions

The application instructions are solely for the purpose of meeting the application standard process. The Board’s rules and regulations and standards are recorded in 237 CMR 12 thru 23 and may be perused on the Board website at www.mass.gov/dpl/boards/el/cmr.htm or may be obtained in hard copy form the MA state house bookstore by calling 617-727-2834. It is every licensee’s responsibility to become familiar with these rules that are necessary for licensing maintenance and compliance.

1. Prior to completing this application you must check with the Board for which states currently have existing reciprocity agreements with Massachusetts. Only licenses by examination from those states will be eligible for reciprocity.
2. Applicants for either a Class A (Master) or Class B (Journeyman) shall legibly complete and notarize an application form for submittal to the Board for its approval.
3. Applications shall be accompanied by payment in full of the non-refundable required fee of \$208 – Journeyman, \$310 – Master in the form of a certified check, postal money order, or express money order made payable to the Commonwealth of Mass.
4. A certified Statement of Registration from the licensing Board of the state from which the applicant is applying shall be submitted; the Statement of Registration shall include the applicant's full name, address, license type and number, shall indicate whether the license is current and in good standing, and shall be certified by an appropriate official and bear the Board seal. Copies of licenses will not be accepted in place of a certified statement.
5. All applications, papers and other documents submitted to the Board in connection with an application for licensure without examination shall become the property of the Board.
6. Applicants who have been previously examined by the Board for a Master or Journeyman Electrician's license or Systems Contractor or Technician and who have failed either examination shall not be issued a license by reciprocity. 237 CMR 15.02(6).
